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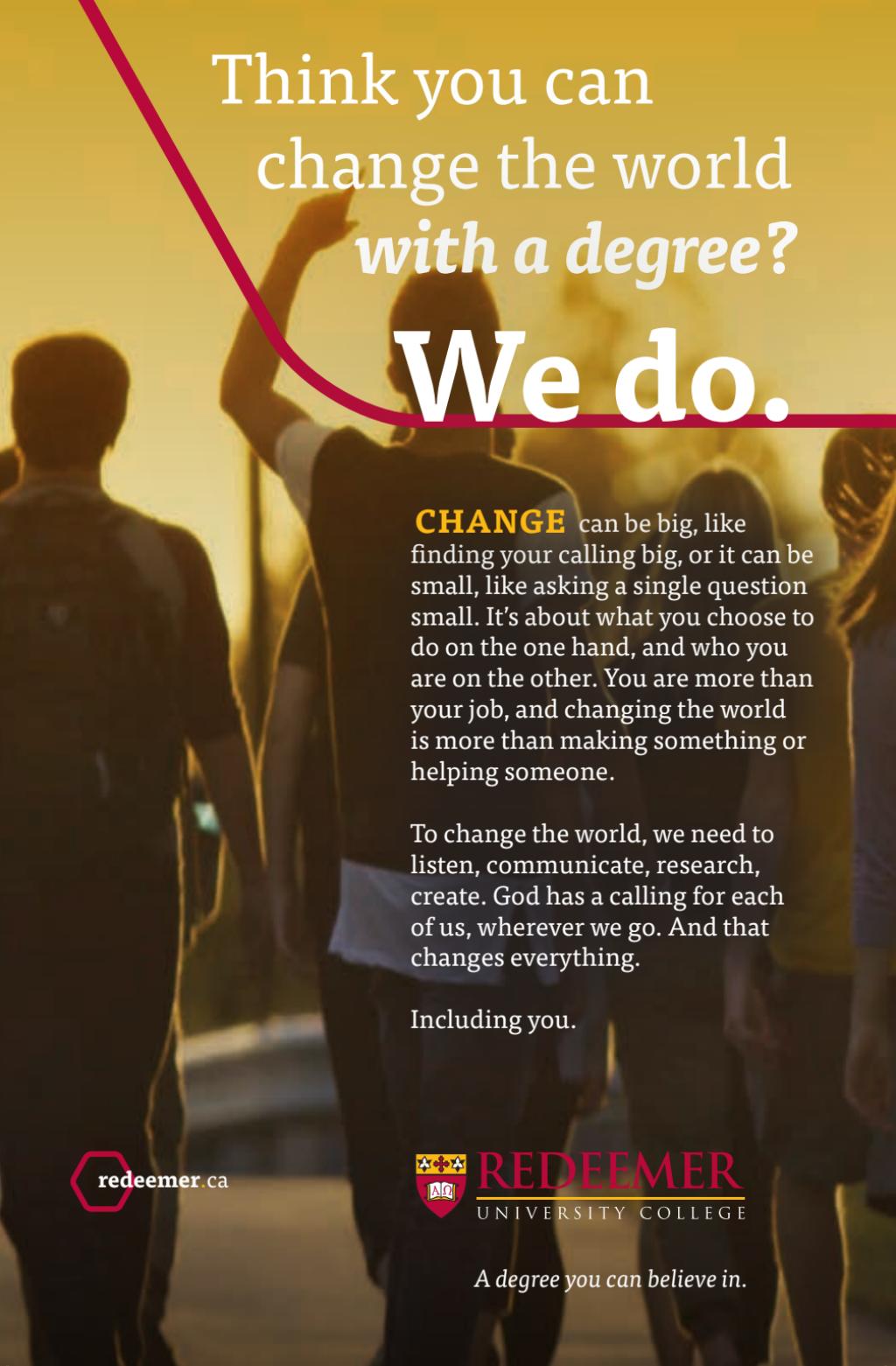

# PRAYER

## PRAYER SANCTUARY

Back by popular demand, it's a quiet, reflective space to meet God. You don't have to sign up, just show up when it's open. You can stay for a few minutes or a few hours. Don't miss it – for some people it's the highlight of the weekend.

## PRAYER LABYRINTH

Make sure you **sign up** for this one. It's an hour long journey that can change your life. Meditate at 11 interactive "stations" through a multimedia experience. Draw close to God in an intentional way throughout this labyrinth experience.

## JOURNEY TO THE CROSS

Journey with Jesus in his final days on earth. Slow down and experience God for yourself. Walk through the Bible story by touching, feeling and seeing things that represent Jesus' path to the Cross. No sign up necessary.

## SPIRITUAL DIRECTION

You can be part of this in three ways – sign up by yourself, with your leader, or as a small group! These are 30 minute sessions where you can share your spiritual heart in a safe place. Hear from God to set your compass going forward. Meet with Lina, Andy, or Douglas as Spiritual Directors who will guide the way.

## CHRISTIAN COUNSELLING

Free professional Christian counselling is for both youth and leaders. **Sign up** to meet Sandra or Charles in 30 minutes time slots. Come by yourself, with a friend, or with a leader.

## SOAKING ROOM

Soaking prayer is simply positioning yourself to express your love to God. It is not intercession. It is not coming to God with a list of needs. It is the act of entering into the presence of God to experience His love - and then allowing the love of God through the Holy Spirit to revolutionize your love for Him. Come and spend some time in a quiet space just for you and God.

## ART DEN

Creativity comes alive at the Art Den! Express yourself in painting, drawing, writing, sculpting or doodling. All materials supplied. Sign up at the back of the auditorium to use the Art Den during one of your small group times, or come and participate during leisure time. It is located in Bricker Academic 112.

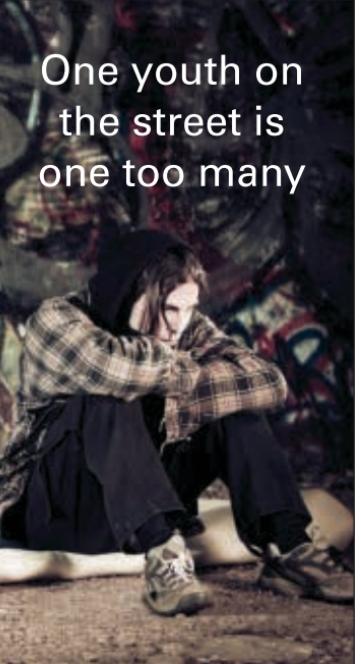

# FAQ

## I've lost something - where can I find it?

Our lost and found box is located at the AOYC Booth in the Athletic Complex during Worship Celebrations, and at the Information Station (near the Dining Courtyard) during meals and leisure time.

## How do mealtimes work at the AOYC?

For any questions, concerns, or a friendly chat, visit the AOYC Booth in the Athletic Complex during Celebration Sessions, or the Information Station (near the Dining Courtyard) during meals and leisure time.

## Why do I need to stay in my dorm at night?

Because your safety is our highest priority, we need to ensure that everyone is in their dorms at night. If you're not there when the Safety Team checks, your parents, youth leader, or emergency contact will be called immediately and arrangements may be made for you to leave the AOYC. Please stay in your dorm room after lights-out.

5. I will not bring to convention any stereo or radio communication device. Any personal listening devices will only be used in my room after lights out.
6. I will not cause damage to any property of the convention or that of the University where the convention is held. I agree to pay for any damage caused in my room or damage I am found to have caused.
7. I will not interfere with any life saving equipment such as fire alarms, extinguishers, fire escapes or first aid kits.
8. I will abide by the 12:00 am curfew - I will not leave my dorm room after this time. If I'm not in my room at that time, I understand that the Safety Team will call my parents immediately.
9. I shall not order food to be delivered after the 11:30 pm curfew. Food delivered after 11:30 pm will be sent back by the Safety Team.
10. All tobacco use will be limited to the designated areas as noted on the campus.
11. I will not bring to convention any form of firework, sparkler, or combustible fuel.
12. Once convention begins, I will not leave the campus where the convention is being held except when participating in off-site events as part of the convention.
13. I will dress in a way that is appropriate and respectful.

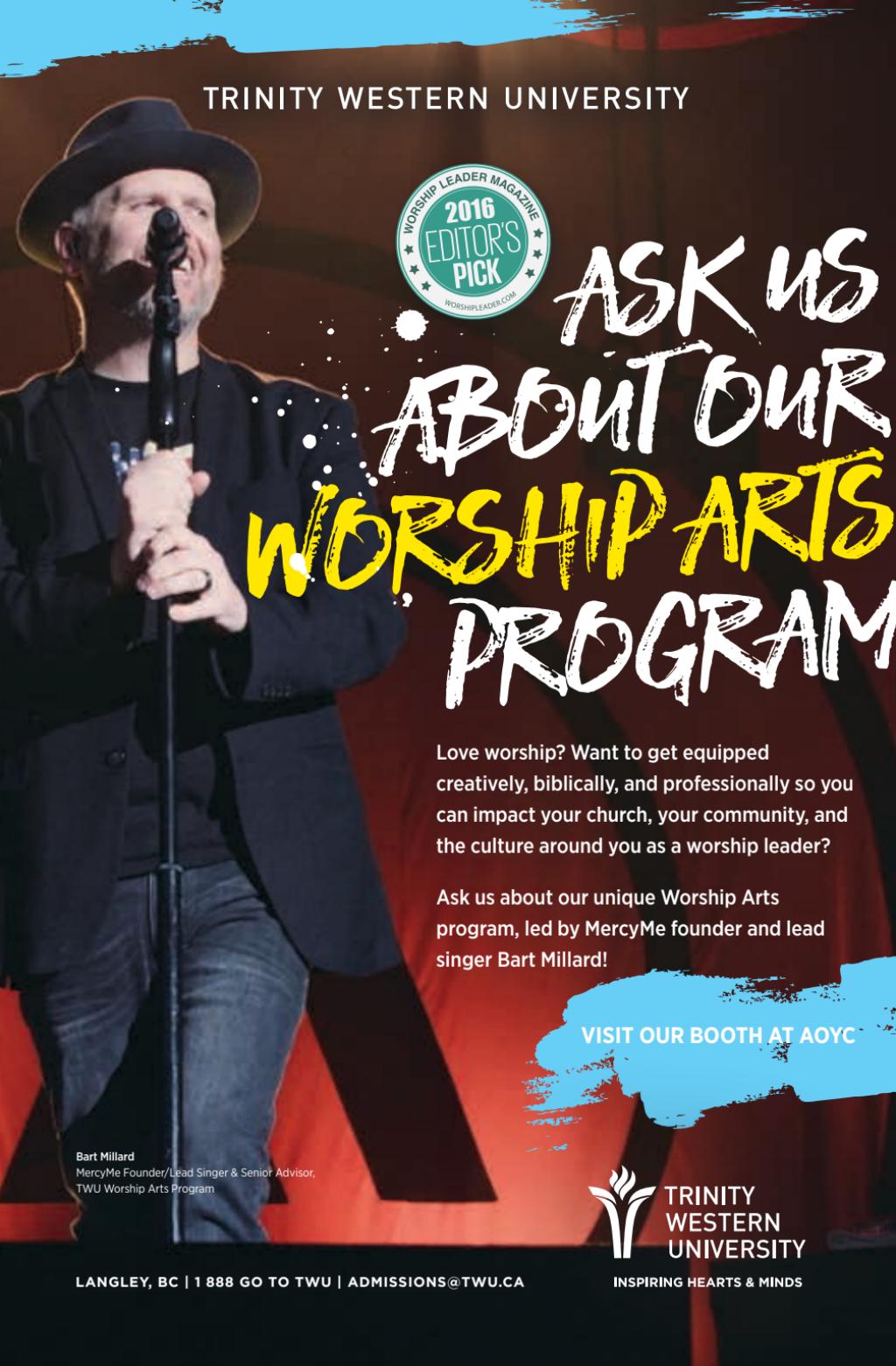

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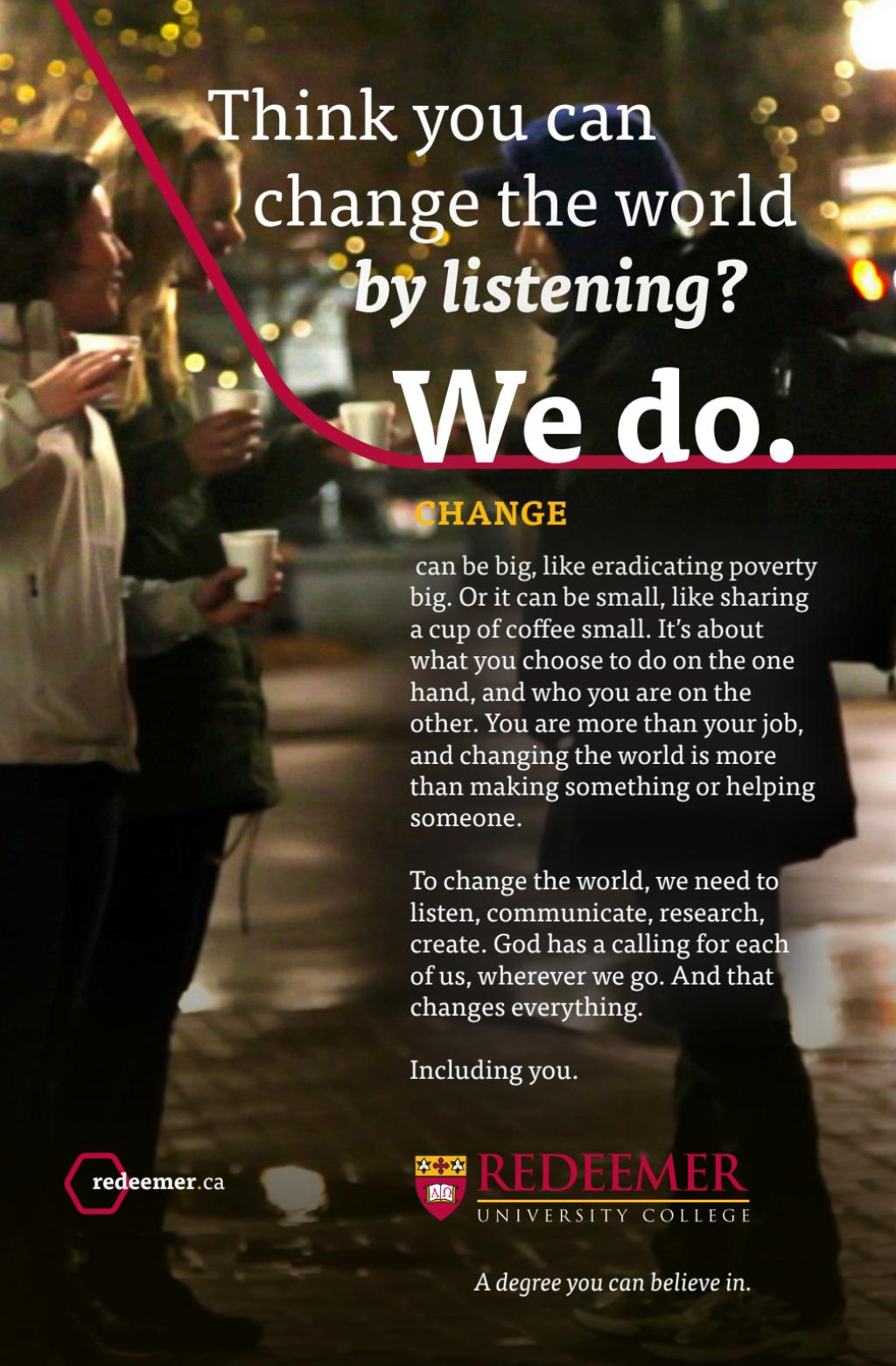
